Her dual expertise in LGBTQ psychology and dialogue across political disagreement inform this enlightening and engaging program.

Evidence-Based Practice With Bisexual Clients

Continuing Education Workshop (2-3 hour)

This informative and interactive session will equip participants with knowledge and skills to enhance mental health services for bisexual+ clients. The presenter will share information regarding bisexual minority stress, physical and mental health disparities, and research on health services for bisexual+ clients. Participants will respond to vignettes and develop strategies for providing equitable, effective, and affirming services for bisexual+ individuals and communities.
